Chair: Tucker C., Sorry couldn't be here

Treasurer: Delynda H. Check book balanced at \$3,192.54 as of 02-27-2010. There is an amount of \$2,881.54 in the account. There are still 5 checks that have not cleared the bank # 708 for \$19.00, #709 for \$150.00, #710 for \$50.00, #711 for \$50.00 and #713 for \$42.00. Surrender to Win: Kerry J. reported that the door is still open and the message of recovery is still being carried in the church basement at 295 Monroe Ave. in Green River.
