Casper, Wy on Feb 5, 2011. At 10:30 there was a workshop that our delegate Tommy O and DeLynda H put on at the request of the host Area on the Service System

Not sure what the Delegate reported as I don't have copy of his report.

Alternate Delegate Reported a lot of information coming from the World level. You can check out any updates and further information of the Service System materials online at www.na.org/servicesystem. There is a great deal of information so she (and I) encourage you do research it and check back often. Also, there is a lot of discussion on the bulletin boards so see what other people are saying. The WCNA 34 is set for San Diego, Sep 1-4, 2011. Registrations are available online and Early Birds Registration ends March 31, 2011, Pre-Registration ends July 28, 2011. The approval draft for the "Living Clean: The Journey Continues" will be ready in April 2011, so keep an eye out for that coming soon. The 2010 NA Literature Survey is available online until April 1, 2011 and if you haven't filled it out and want to participate you can go to www.na.org/litsurvey. Results from the survey are expected to be incorporated into the strategic plan for the 2012-2014 cycle. She did bring a copy of the 2009-2010 Annual Report and the total amount of money that the Region (including home groups, areas and the region itself donated to NAWS was approx. \$2,760.00.

Web Servant Steve H. reported that he is using a new program to work on the website with more options (for instance people who use different browsers to see the same thing, and the ability of people with smart phones to view the information). The Convention section is updated with the flyer and Convention Guidelines. The Service section does have minutes posted as well as a contact list and archives. To access it the user name is **region** and the password is **123456**. There are also many events listed under the Events section that are from out nearby regions in order to help support them. So check it out !

URMRCNA XII - Chair showed up and reported are planning a Pre-Assembly Party before the Region Assembly in Riverton on April 1, starting at 6pm.

There were four areas represented at the Regional meeting. Central Wyoming reported new meetings and their new meetings should be posted on the website. Their H&I goes into 4 of their local facilities regularly and is asking if any other area is willing to step up to share the commitment to the Wyoming Women's Center in Lusk.

Wyo-Braska continues to do well with their commitment and RCM.

Central Basin, not sure as I didn't take real good notes.

Freedom Seekers, wasn't represented and had no report.

Wyoming Western Area, I reported that we completed an Area Inventory, have been workshopping the Service System, got the Learning Days Guidelines integrated into the Area Guidelines (and when and where the Learning Days is scheduled to be).

3. USSC discussion. This was the most talked about topic at the regional meeting. Discussion on sending our Delegate to this followed and the Central Wyoming Area offered to pay for our Delegate to the USSC to be held in Wichita, the Delegate declined their offer. A member from the Central Basin (?) showed up and passed out some information for anybody interested in the USSC and some of the things leading up to it. I think there is going to be much more discussion on this and I've been having mixed feelings regarding this topic.

4. Name change of the region to Wyo-braska region. Discussion followed and we asked the RCM to take back to their Area the "purpose/intent" of the motion.

Elections: Terry M from Powell was nominated as URMRCNA XIII Chair, we questioned Terry, discussed her qualifications, voted and Terry M will be Chair of URMRCNA XIII. Scott made the meeting and let us know that this would be his last meeting as Treasurer.

Note: the Secretary and Treasurer positions for the Region are open and they would like to get these positions filled, so pass it on to your groups for anybody interested that would be good for these positions to try to make it to the next Regional Meeting in June.
