Old Business:

No positions able to be filled at this time.

Area Inventory:

We have Laura from Pinedale and Delynda asks the body if the inventory discussion can be at a different time in order to help the Pinedale group at the next Area meeting. Body asks Laura if they would like some help and she said she would love the Area to put on a presentation for their group on service on June 25th. Mark asks the body to have the inventory in August and provide a workshop for Pinedale, and there were no objections. The body then discussed having the inventory after the meeting and body approved.

Guidelines:

Emailed out but changed revised and approved to match the minutes on the front page and will be put on the area web site.

New Business:

Budgets:

Budgets are to be submitted at this meeting and approved at the next meeting. Delynda says that if we keep the budget at \$2870 and we have \$1960 in the account now, the same budgeted amount as last year could result in a lower balance. Delynda asked if we wanted to cut funding in any items and that we can cut travel by \$200 if we need to but could also lower our donations to region. The web site will be the full \$300 when we pay. We are currently spending about \$1500 per year and have donations of approximately \$830+/- which is typical and we also have a \$350 reserve. The body discussed lowering \$150 from the budget amount of last year and would like to take this amount to the groups to approve at the next Area meeting. Total amount would be \$2570.

Regional Workshop:

What does our area want from the region? Discussions on LSU and GSU, and also wanting to just do a basic commitment workshop with keeping addicts coming back, learning about service, following through, structure. Body had no objections to combining the two together in a workshop on these topics combined.

Anonymity:

Diane reported a problem with probation and parole and an addict who had been providing documents which included writing a list of first and last names of addicts who chaired meetings. Diane talked to P&P and said that information should not have been provided to them. Outside enterprises don't understand our Traditions. Suggestions included having Tradition meetings, meeting on court cards and sharing with addicts what to do and not to do. Mark then decided he would appoint a
